Format: 2 hours remote + 2 hours in person

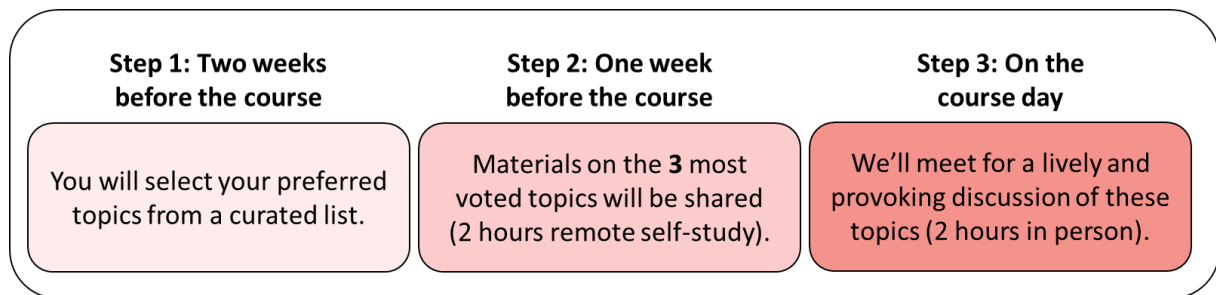
