Handout: Evaluation Criteria

Applications for the Rahel Goitein-Straus-Programm of the Medical Faculty of Heidelberg are each evaultated by an interdisciplinary selection committee in which equal opportunities officers (*Gleichstellungsbeauftragte*) also take part.

Major Criteria for the evaluation include (but are not limited to):

- the applicant's previous scientific achievements, both during their university studies as well as their doctoral work
- the documented preparatory work for the planed project, such as aquired methodological knowledge, lab experience, and publications
- grants and awards already received as well as any third-party funding raised by the applicant
- the innovative impact of the project
- the quality of the research project and the application
- the convincing motivation and presentation of professional career goals
- The selection committee reserves the right to consider familial and social aspects in addition to the aforementioned criteria when assessing eligibility for funding.
